## **A BILL**

To authorize the use of off-highway vehicles in certain areas of the Capitol Reef National Park, Utah.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. USE OF OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLES IN CERTAIN**  
4                    **AREAS OF THE CAPITOL REEF NATIONAL**  
5                    **PARK, UTAH.**

6        (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

7            (1) COVERED ROAD.—The term “covered road”  
8        means the portions of each of Burr Trail Road, Ca-  
9        thedral Road, Hartnet Road, Highway 24, Notom  
10       Bullfrog Road, Polk Creek Road, Oil Ranch Road,

1 and Baker Ranch Road that are located within the  
2 boundaries of the Capitol Reef National Park in the  
3 State.

4 (2) OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE.—The term “off-  
5 highway vehicle” has the meaning given the term in  
6 State law.

7 (3) STATE.—The term “State” means the State  
8 of Utah.

9 (b) APPLICABLE LAW.—State law shall apply to the  
10 use of motor vehicles (including off-highway vehicles) on  
11 a covered road.
