- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Transparency in5 COVID-19 Expenditures Act".

6 SEC. 2. COVID-19 RELIEF FUNDING AUDIT.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Comptroller General of the
8 United States shall conduct an audit of the use of all fund9 ing provided by the legislation described in subsection (b)
10 and submit a report on the findings of such audit to Con11 gress.
