A BILL

To amend title 28 of the United States Code to prevent the transfer of actions arising under the antitrust laws in which a State is a complainant.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “State Antitrust En-
5 forcement Venue Act of 2021”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS.**

2 Section 1407 of title 28 of the United States Code
3 is amended—

4 (1) in subsection (g) by inserting “or a State”
5 after “United States”, and

6 (2) by striking subsection (h).

7 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

8 This Act and the amendments made by this Act, shall
9 take effect on June 1, 2021.
