6 3”.

1 In section 2, in the section heading, strike “**DEC-**  
2 **LARATION**” and insert “**DECLARATIONS**”.

3 In section 2, strike “following declaration” and all  
4 that follows through the period at the end and insert the  
5 following: “following declarations:

6 (1) The Kigali amendment is not self-executing.

7 (2) The People’s Republic of China is not a de-  
8 veloping country, and the United Nations and other  
9 intergovernmental organizations should not treat the  
10 People’s Republic of China as such.

11 At the end, add the following:

12 **SEC. 3. CONDITION.**

13 The advice and consent of the Senate under section  
14 1 is subject to the following condition: Prior to the Thirty-  
15 Fifth Meeting of the Parties to the Montreal Protocol, the  
16 Secretary of State shall transmit to the Secretariat of the  
17 Vienna Convention for the Protection of the Ozone Layer  
18 a proposal to amend Decision I/12E, “Clarification of  
19 terms and definitions: developing countries,” made at the  
20 First Meeting of the Parties, to remove the People’s Re-  
21 public of China.
